Technical Sergeant Scott Sauer plays trumpet with the United States Air Force Band of Mid-America. He is a member of the Concert Band, Ceremonial Band, and the Shades of Blue Jazz Ensemble.

A graduate of Eastern Washington University, Sergeant Sauer holds a Bachelor of Music degree in Trumpet Performance. Sergeant Sauer has taught private lessons and been a freelance trumpet player in the Spokane area. In addition, he has performed with Bob Curnow's New Jazz Repertory Ensemble and the Disneyland All American College Band.

In 1998, Sergeant Sauer auditioned for the U. S. Air Force Bands & Music Program, and was assigned to the Band of the Golden West, Travis Air Force Base. In 2003 Sergeant Sauer was assigned to the Band of the Pacific at Elmendorf Air Force Base, Alaska. He returned stateside in 2008 to the Band of Mid-America.

His military awards include the Air Force Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters, and the Air Force Achievement medal.
